Pre-K 4 SA's Professional Learning Department is offering courses to assist adult learners in obtaining the necessary coursework to apply for a **Preschool**Child Development Associate (CDA).*

High-quality early childhood educators have a lifelong influence on the children they teach.

Program Details:

- Candidates pay for the CDA observation and exam (\$425, if application is completed online).
- Textbooks available for check-out and portfolio notebooks provided.
- Assistance with Professional Portfolio creation, selecting a Professional Development Specialist, and test registration offered.

Candidates:

- Are responsible for obtaining current and valid Certificates of Completion for first aid and child CPR courses on their own.
- Must live or work in the City of San Antonio.
- Have a high school diploma or GED.
- Must be employed working with children ages 3-5 years of age.
- Need 480 hours of experience working with children ages
 3-5 within three years of submitting a CDA application.
